The East Sussex Teacher Training Partnership seeks to promote excellence through a drive to sustain high quality provision and outcomes for trainees. The leadership of the programme is rooted in an accurate understanding of local, regional and national teacher recruitment needs.

Our principle is that training places should be filled by those best able to fulfil the requirements of the programme that leads to the award of Qualified Teacher Status and go on to become successful, high-quality practitioners.

Key facts about Initial Teacher Training

- ESTTP has over 15 years' experience as an accredited school-based Initial Teacher Training provider.
- The programme lasts one year, commencing in September. During the year you will train alongside experienced teaching staff, building up your teaching practice.
- You will train each week on a range of professional studies sessions and subject specific training sessions. A consecutive Key Stage experience and second school placement is arranged by the provider.
- All trainees train for Qualified Teacher Status, which is what is required to apply for teaching positions. There is also an opportunity to complete a Postgraduate Certificate in Education, which can lead to Master's level credits.
- You can train at a range of placements schools, including academies, free schools and individual schools across East Sussex and the surrounding area.

Entry requirements

Before starting your training you will need:

- GCSE minimum grade C in English, maths and science or equivalent
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, 2:2 and above is preferred but not mandatory
- Passed the National Skills Tests in maths and English



Training options

Training provides a strong focus on practical, classroom-based experience.

Primary Tuition Fees - Fees are £7,500.

You can apply for a student loan or self-fund.

School Direct Salaried - These training places attract a salary whilst you train. You will be paid as an unqualified teacher. To apply for a salaried training place you will need to obtain the support of a school before submitting your application. Schools should contact us directly regarding salary funding options.

If you are applying for a salaried training place you will need to indicate in your personal statement that a school/academy can provisionally offer a school training placement.
